### 1. Read Instructions







A sensor in the bottom middle detects the level of illumination and activates the IR LED in low-lighting conditions.


### Body

### · Power In (DC 12V)

Connect it to the power adapter (DC 12V).

### · BNC Video Out

Connect it to the DVR.

### · OSD Button

Use the button to set the OSD menu.



You can change the video output format by using the OSD button.

- **CVBS**: Press the **UP** button three times, and then press the center of the OSD button.
- **TVI**: Press the **LEFT** button three times, and then press the center of the OSD button.
- AHD: Press the RIGHT button three times, and then press the center of the OSD button.







- Check the wall or ceiling to see if it needs to be reinforced. The camera may fall off if the wall or ceiling is not strong enough to support its weight.
- Install the camera in a shaded area. If the camera is installed in direct sunlight, it may be affected adversely.



- 1 Screw the mounting bracket to the wall or ceiling by using screws(3) provided with the camera.
- 2 Adjust the camera angle by bending the stand.
- 3 Connect external devices, network and power adapter.
- 4 Apply power.



# Troubleshooting

Problem	Check
The main unit won't turn on.	<ul><li>Check the power cable connection.</li><li>Check the power outlet.</li></ul>
I can't see Live videos.	<ul><li>Check the camera's power status.</li><li>Check the connection status of the camera with DVR.</li></ul>
Images are blurry.	<ul> <li>Make sure the lens is clean. If not, clean it using a soft piece of cloth or a brush.</li> <li>If there is too much light coming into the camera or the camera is picking up an overly bright light source, adjust the camera's position/angle accordingly.</li> </ul>
Video color appears incorrect,	Check the white balance settings. If using the <b>Auto</b> option, it may take some time for the white balance to be adjusted.
Images are blinking.	If the camera is pointed at the sun or a fluorescent lamp, adjust the camera's angle away.
